

Frame-conditions for a valuable research

Professor Kurt Franz from Ulm (Germany) showed which were the frame-conditions of the research in physics in the private economy, so that the results of the research be optimal. Professor Franz led the Research Institute of the company AEG-Telefunken.

The frame-conditions of a quality research, with valuable results are, in Franz's opinion, as follows:

1. To ensure the hunting of great perspective ideas
2. The corresponding endowment in the established direction of research.
3. The financing in accordance to the principle: "More money leads to a better success".
4. To take into account the fact that in the research, from which valuable results are expected, not only the quality of the researcher is important but also the quality of the argument with which the researcher will have decided upon the respective research.
5. The researcher must have the confidence of the financer. When funds are requested, it is wise not to give short and simple arguments. The more profound and the more detailed, the better is.
6. The financer must be patient both with the research subject and the money that must produce the finalized research.
7. Not to equalize the wishes, the needs and the work possibilities.
8. The researcher must have extremely intense contacts and exchanges with the colleagues, he/she must present largely the researches and to publish a high number of research works.
